Patrol Equipment and Logistics

Each Patrol is to set up their own self-sufficient camp

These will serve as useful checklists some variations may be required to fit your Patrol needs.

Tents, easy-up shelters, poles, cooking and dishwashing equipment are the responsibility of each patrol.

Patrol equipment is to be packed in such a manner that it can be easily transported or carried to the campsite.

A small wagon carry cart will work well for moving equipment to and from the campsite.

Water: Potable (drinking) water will NOT be provided. Please bring your own water.

There are pit toilets (outhouses)

Please respect these shared spaces and clean up after yourself.

Please notify the Responsible Guider right away if there is a problem with any of these facilities.

Please do not use any of the pit toilets for garbage or wastewater disposal.

Use designated fire pits. Firewood is supplied

All participants (adults and youth) are required to always stay within the boundaries of Camp Ispah.
